

Based on Rinat's <u>TEDx Talk</u>, a world acclaimed social justice project that aims to look at gender equality from a scientific perspective. Looking at the menstrual cycle as a framework for nature's life cycles and hence demonstrating how the unique female qualities can be leveraged can be leveraged to create a thriving society.

A neuroscience based, sensory experience helping people deal with anxiety where forgotten memories are transformed into tangible illustrations..

Working with the public home for homeless people suffering from various mental health issues in NY we developed a methodology based on neuroscience that helps people relate better to their anxieties. Through this they connected to a positive forgotten memory that was then sent to an illustrator and returned to them in a framed picture to hang by their bed an reinforce these positive memories.
